Dolby Digital Encoder 1.1.0.172

The following issues have been fixed in version 1.1.0.172

Issue ID	Description	
19773	No GUI of Dolby Digital Encoder shows up when executing an export in Dolby Digital format. Instead the application crashes.	
19324	The Dolby Digital Encoder does not display the correct time code in the "Time Code" tab when the byte mode "Timestamp SMPTE" is selected.	
19250	Dolby Digital Encoder disables export options for all other formats.	
17709 11106	Dolby Digital Encoder crashes application when setting "Byte Mode" Parameter to "Timestamp SMPTE".	

The following table describes issues you may encounter using this software as well as possible workarounds.

Issue ID	Issue	Solution
12790 17070 19505	Exporting "as wave file" creates stereo wave files with ".ac3" extension instead of ".wav".	After export, manually rename the file extension to ".wav". PC: If file extensions are not visible (hidden) on your system, locate exported file and right-click it to open context menu. Select "Properties" and replace ".a3" with ".wav" and click "ok". MAC: localize exported file and ctrl+click on it. Select "Get Info" and change the file extension ".ac3" to ".wav". Press enter and confirm with "Use .wav".
